Barclays' 2024 half-year financial results

With Group income of £13.3bn, profit before tax increased to £4.2bn. The financial update to 30 June 2024 showed the Group generated 2.9p of dividends per share and 18.6p of earnings per share.

Group CEO C.S. Venkatakrishnan (Venkat) said: "We are making good progress on our three-year plan to improve Barclays' operational and financial performance, generating higher returns and attractive shareholder distributions. The new plan aims to make Barclays simpler, better and more balanced."



Venkat added: "We had a Return on Tangible Equity (RoTE) of 11.1% in the first half of 2024, which puts us on track for our target of greater than 10% RoTE in 2024. We completed the sale of the performing Italian mortgage book, announced the sale of the German consumer finance business, and completed the acquisition of Tesco Bank in November 2024. We announced a share buyback of up to £750m, with total capital distributions to shareholders of £1.2bn in respect of the first half of 2024."

Finding support and comfort through conversation


After the sudden loss of her husband in 2000, Elaine* faced the daunting task of adjusting to life as a widow. With the support of her loved ones, she worked hard to keep her mind and body active. However, a series of health issues over the years brought about significant stress and financial concerns.

Having worked in a bank for 11 years, Elaine turned to the Bank Workers Charity for help. To her relief, they were able to assist her. During a conversation with a client adviser. Elaine mentioned that her cooker had broken, and the charity provided a grant for a new one.

Elaine cherished the opportunity to chat, especially since her health issues limited her ability to socialise outside her home. Recognising this, the charity's client adviser suggested she join their friendship telephone service, in partnership with Age UK.

The friendship telephone service aims to combat loneliness by fostering meaningful connections through conversation. Sometimes, all it takes is a friendly chat. Each call, led by a trained facilitator, lasts approximately one hour and happens at the same time each week. Groups consist of a maximum of six members, creating a safe and welcoming environment. Registering for the service is simple, and once you've registered, all you need to do is answer the phone at the agreed time.

Elaine expressed her gratitude for the weekly calls, stating, "I eagerly anticipate each conversation. It's wonderful to have someone to talk to, reminiscing and sharing stories about my banking days. Many people, like me, struggle to get out and about. These calls prevent loneliness and bring people together."

American cemetery visit

On Thursday 9 May, the LEPC paid a visit to the Cambridge American Cemetery and Memorial.

The cemetery is a meticulously maintained burial ground that holds the remains of 3,800 individuals. At the end of the Second World War, a portion of them were repatriated to their home countries. Tragically, 900 lives were lost to meningitis during their training here, as penicillin was not yet embraced by the USA. Additionally, some succumbed to local traffic accidents and common illnesses, although the majority of those interred here are veterans of the Second World War.

Resembling the iconic Lincoln Memorial Reflecting Pool in Washington D.C., a picturesque scene features serene waterways that gracefully guide visitors towards the tranquil Chapel of Rest.

Standing as the longest memorial wall in Europe, a solemn tribute serves as a poignant reminder for all the soldiers who never made it back home. Each name etched on the wall bears witness to their sacrifice, accompanied only by their rank and state of birth. It is a deeply sombre sight, evoking a profound sense of sadness.

Within the Chapel of Rest, there lies an exquisite altar adorned with breathtaking mosaics.

The day continued with a relaxing retail therapy session at a local garden centre in Coton. As the day drew to a close, Club members embarked on their journey back to Essex via the M11.

The small branch experience

When I was interviewed by Barclays in Nottingham back in 1961, I was asked, "If you are successful, where would you like to work?" Without hesitation, I replied, "In the city centre," as I loved the vibrant buzz of a bustling city.


As it turned out. I was successful, but my assigned branch was in Eastwood – a small mining town known mainly for D.H. Lawrence. Initially, I was a bit disappointed, but it guickly became one of the best experiences of my career. The branch was small, with just six staff members. Our manager, who resembled Captain Mainwaring from Dad's Army, was a true character – a gentleman farmer and a Justice of the Peace. We rarely saw him during the day, as after opening the post and reassuring us that "there was nothing in the post to worry you," he would disappear to fulfil his duties as Chairman of the Juvenile Court in Nottingham eight miles away.

This set-up presented its own challenges, especially since we had two sub-branches to manage. Each day, one of the staff members, along with an ex-miner guard, would take the necessary notes and coins by bus to one of these sub-branches, where they worked four days a week.

My mornings at the branch began in the cellar, filling the coal bucket for the fire in the manager's office. Next, I would mix the special indelible ink for the ink wells in the banking hall and for posting the hand-ledgers. Blotting paper had to be checked and replaced, especially if it showed traces of the previous day's transactions. Working in a small branch was a great experience, as it required learning a variety of tasks – quite different from the specialised roles in a multi-staffed city branch.

Sending money as an H.V.P. (High Value Packet) to the Post Office was a carefully planned operation. Two staff members were involved: one colleague carried the cash in a suitcase strapped to their wrist, and I accompanied them, always walking closest to the traffic to avoid any surprises. I had a whistle tied around my neck as an alarm. We couldn't vary our route, as that would have been even more dangerous.

I was also given the responsibility to "man" one of the subbranches alongside my ex-miner guard. The building belonged to the Post Office next door, and being short in stature, I struggled to hand cash over the wide mahogany counter and under the grille.



Often, I had to lift myself onto the counter using my elbows, but this would sometimes cause me to accidentally trigger the alarm. The Post Office owner would quickly rush in with a broom, asking, "Are you all right, my duck?"

I have many stories from my time at Eastwood, but perhaps my most notable claim to fame is that on one occasion the money we prepared so carefully to send to London, labelled as "Surplus to Requirements," never made it to its destination. It was stolen in the Great Train Robbery!

Memories of a Barclays rugby tournament

Merfyn Williams -**D-Day veteran**

I received connection Issue 84 and particularly enjoyed the article on D-Day and Barclays. As the 80th Anniversary approached, one man was in my thoughts.

Back in 1967. I was transferred to Llandeilo branch where our Chief Clerk was John Arthur Merfyn Williams – affectionately known as Jammy. He was a lovely man but shocked me one day by being uncharacteristically irritable – he even threw a pen at me.

Our Manager I D Davies saw this and took me to one side to explain that Merfyn had been in the D-Day landings. He had a piece of his skull shot off by a German sniper and a metal plate had been inserted to cover the wound. When the weather was cold, the plate would contract and cause him to have terrible headaches.

Despite his struggles, Merfyn was very good to all his staff. I recall one occasion when he stormed into J D's office with my appraisal, which he was typing up for Head Office. He demanded that it was changed to reflect the hard work I had done, insisting the original report wasn't good enough.

In October 1970, as my wife Pam and I were expecting our first child, Merfyn told me to tell her to "hang on" as his son Derek was about to start at Glangwili Hospital, and he hoped Derek would be in charge of the birth. As it happened, Christopher didn't arrive until the 12th, and it was in fact Dr Derek who delivered him. Merfyn was delighted.

After his wife died, Merfyn moved to Ruislip to live with Derek. Every Christmas, his was always the first card to arrive. Merfyn has sadly passed away, but we still get a card every year from Derek and his wife.

The importance of customer account ledgers

A look back at some famous customer accounts from the Barclays Group Archives.

Barclays Group Archives fill a mile and a half of shelving in an unassuming building on an industrial estate in Manchester. A substantial proportion of this space is occupied by customer account ledgers, including a few for the accounts of some very famous names.

Three hundred years of history

Large, heavy and unwieldy, the ledgers were the bread and butter of banking for nearly 300 years. The ledgers are an insight into the former workings of Barclays, but they also tell a social history through the intimate details of the finances of thousands of customers.

Barclays has acquired many smaller banks over the years, and the majority of the ledgers belonging to the acquired banks have not survived. However, there are two significant collections remaining, those from Goslings and Sharpe of Fleet Street, and those from Parsons, Thomson and Company of Oxford.

Goslings and Sharpe's history can be traced back to 1650, and the Barclays Group Archives contain a remarkable 658 customer ledgers dating from 1717 through to 1896 when Goslings joined Barclays.

Parsons, Thomson and Company, also known as the Oxford Old Bank, was established in 1771. The 210 remaining customer ledgers held by Barclays Group Archives run from 1775 to 1901.

Detailed ledgers provide unique insights

The value of historic bank accounts was explained beautifully by Jenny Woolf in her book The Mystery of Lewis Carroll. Woolf spent some time in the Barclays Group Archives as part of her research into the famous author's life. She wrote:

"What I discovered, in a windowless book-lined room over several weeks, was a breakthrough. Here were hard, unaltered and previously unknown facts, the accounts shown exactly as they had been when the clerks closed their big leatherbound ledgers over a century before. No devoted members of Carroll's family had scrutinised this material. Nobody had had the chance to obliterate certain records of certain payments and insert others they thought more suitable. The fact that this material was utterly untouched made it unique as an important new source of Lewis Carroll information."


Ledgers of the rich and famous

Lewis Carroll (real name Charles Lutwidge Dodgson) (1832-1898)

Charles Lutwidge Dodgson wrote Alice's Adventures in Wonderland under the pseudonym, Lewis Carroll. He was a Lecturer in Mathematics at Christ Church, Oxford from 1855 to 1881, and also served as Curator of the Common Room for several years.

Dodgson's account with the Oxford Old Bank ran from 1856 to 1900 (two years after his death). The accounts show that Dodgson financially supported his siblings and their children throughout his life, supplemented his income with investments in railway shares, and subscribed to a large number of charities. They also show his earnings from his books, with regular deposits from his publisher, Macmillan, which seem to have been quite variable – as much as £1,340 in 1891, and £406 in 1897 (approximately £1.2 million and £361,300 respectively today). Costs associated with the books can also be seen – artist Sir John Tenniel received £138 for illustrations for Alice's Adventures in Wonderland, and £290 for Through the Looking Glass.

There are also payments for items like photographic equipment (Dodgson is known to have been a keen photographer) and to companies supplying other new-fangled inventions, such as a Stylographic reproducing pen, and a Singer Velociman tricycle. As Curator of the Common Room, Dodgson was responsible for buying large quantities of wine and spirits – purchases which he would make through his bank account, to be reimbursed at a later date.



Georgiana Cavendish, Duchess of Devonshire (1757-1806)

Georgiana Cavendish was an 18th century English socialite renowned in aristocratic circles for her beauty, wit, charm and style. The duchess was just 17 when she married William Cavendish, fifth Duke of Devonshire, in 1774. The union was to prove an unhappy one, but Georgiana became a leading light in English society.

The duchess, who counted Marie Antoinette and the Prince of Wales among her friends, led a fascinating, complicated and ultimately tragic life. One of the most talked about women in England, her sense of style sparked myriads of fashion crazes - including oneyard-tall hair towers full of artificial birds and fruit.

However, it would be wrong to dismiss Georgiana merely as a profligate socialite; she was a woman who was not afraid to challenge the conventions of her time. Unlike many women of her class, she was a devoted mother – choosing to breastfeed her children herself, rather than employing a wet-nurse. At a time when women were not expected to involve themselves in politics, she actively campaigned on behalf of the Whig party, both at social events and on the streets.

Georgiana's main bank account was with Coutts, but she also banked with Goslings and Sharpe, once for a mere six days in 1790 and again in 1795 until her death in 1806. It is possible that the duchess only opened the accounts to gain more credit, as she was continuously - and notoriously - in debt.

Entries from her accounts shed light on the duchess's spending, with one showing a payment of £600 on 14 October 1795 from her brother-in-law Lord Bessborough. Despite her husband's extreme wealth, Georgiana was known to ask friends and family for loans on a regular basis.

Georgiana tried extremely hard to keep her gambling debts hidden from her husband. It was only after her death, aged just 48, that the duke finally discovered the extent of what she owed – which was nearly £4,000,000 in today's terms. He apparently remarked, "Is that all?"



Oscar Wilde (1854-1900)

Oscar Wilde appears in the ledgers of the Oxford Old Bank from February 1875 to June 1883. Wilde studied Literae Humaniores, a course combining classics and ancient philosophy, at Magdalen College, Oxford, from 1874 to 1878. A novelist, playwright, and poet, some of his most famous works include The Importance of Being Earnest, The Picture of Dorian Grey and An Ideal Husband.

Although Wilde left Oxford on graduation in 1878, he kept his account with the Old Bank for several years. A pencil note in the ledger for late 1880 gives an address of 5 Little St. lames Street. Pall Mall (a block of flats immediately behind St. James's Palace) - an address that does not seem to be mentioned in published books on Wilde.

Activity in the account reflects Wilde's time at Oxford, with minimal entries during the summer holidays, plus an additional gap in April 1877 when he was 'sent down' (suspended from the College) for failing to turn up at the start of term.

In February 1875, Wilde paid £9 6s 8d to Spiers, an emporium on Oxford High Street where he is known to have purchased china, ornaments, a decanter, playing cards, drinking glasses, coffee cups, and a breakfast service. Another Oxford High Street tradesman to feature is the tailor, Muir.

One of the frequent payments from 1877 onwards is to St. Stephen's Club, a London club opened in 1870, and there are also payments to the 'Apollo', and to 'Churchill Lodge' which seem to have been for subscriptions to Masonic lodges in Oxford. Further Masonic connections can be seen in payments to an Oxford jeweller, Osmond, some of which are known to have been for Masonic regalia.

Other payments from Wilde's account are for 'music' and to the renowned Oxford hostelry, The Mitre. He also paid (or repaid?) money to various family members including his mother. Lady Wilde (1821-96), and his elder brother William.


